Students have the responsibility:

- To be present and prompt at all official band functions;
- To give their best effort at all times (We can't ask for more than your best!);
- To treat peers, staff, and boosters respectfully;
- To meet reasonable expectations of performance and behavior;
- To give peers the room to make mistakes, learn, and grow;
- To strive for excellence.

Parents have the right:

- To be treated respectfully by peers, students, and staff;
- To have information distributed to them regarding schedules, expectations, and standards in a timely manner;
- To be helped in understanding how to support their band student progress toward excellence.

Parents have the responsibility:

- To help their student be present and prompt at all band functions;
- To fulfill the financial obligations of being in the Patriot Band in a timely manner, as they are able.
- To treat peers, students, and staff respectfully;
- To make a note of schedules and information sent home;
- To help their student strive for excellence and give their best effort

Staff members have the right:

- To be treated with respect by peers, students, and parents;
- To be informed of absences and special circumstances in advance;
- To be given the opportunity to learn and grow;
- To be given the support to help students progress toward excellence

Staff members have the responsibility:

- To foster an atmosphere that leads to student growth, musically and socially;
